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
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




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#### J&J Janssen Pause.....



- On April 13, 2021, CDC and FDA recommended a pause in the use of Johnson & Johnson's Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine.
- Nearly 7 million doses administered in the United States.
- 6 reports of cerebral venous sinus thrombosis with thrombocytopenia (CVST) in people after receiving the J&J/Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine.
- All reports occurred among women between the ages of 18 and 48, and symptoms occurred six to 13 days after vaccination.
- Report adverse events to the <u>Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS)</u>

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#### **CVST**




- Symptoms
  - Including severe headache, backache, new neurologic symptoms, severe abdominal pain, shortness of breath, leg swelling, petechiae, or new or easy bruising
- Do not treat with heparin unless HIT test is negative
- High dose IVIG is recommended
- Mark any Janssen COVID-19 vaccine in your inventory "Do not use. Awaiting guidance."



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### How Long Does the Vaccine Last?

- Antibody activity remained high in all age groups (18-55, 56-70, >71) at day 209.
- All participants had detectable activity in different assays
- Relationship between titers and vaccine efficacy is unknown

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#### Vaccine Against Variants

NIH clinical trial evaluating Moderna COVID-19 variant vaccine begins

- Phase 1 variant vaccine trial has began enrolling participants in several US cities
- The variant vaccine candidate developed by Moderna, differs from the currently-authorized Moderna vaccine in that it delivers instructions for making the SARS-CoV-2 spike that incorporates key mutations in the B.1.351 (South Africa) virus variant.



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#### Pfizer and Biontech Report

- Vaccine is highly effective with 91.3% vaccine efficacy observed against COVID-19, measured seven days through up to six months second dose
- Vaccine was 100% effective in preventing COVID-19 cases in South Africa, where the B.1.351 lineage is prevalent
- > 44,000 participants, with > 12,000 vaccinated participants having at least six months follow-up

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
#### What to Expect in the Near Future


- 3rd shot?
  - "The way to get the answer is to just follow people closely enough to determine when that level of efficacy or protection diminishes, both with regard to the level of the antibodies as well as clinical data with regard to breakthrough infections," Dr. Fauci
  - People may need to get booster shots for the COVID vaccines in a year
- Other variants
- P1 (Brazil) and B.1.1.7 (UK)





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## F841, §483.70(h) Medical Director

- The facility must designate a physician to serve as Medical Director. §483.70(h)
- · Implementation of resident care policies; and
- The coordination of medical care in the facility.

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


## Impact of Medical Director Certification on Nursing Home Quality of Care


If a Deficiency Has Been Identified Regarding a Resident's Care

- Medical Director should have had knowledge of a problem with care, or physician services, or lack of resident care policies and practices that meet current professional standards of practice
- \*If there is a clear facility issue and they did not bring their Medical Director into the loop, this is problematic—facilities need to solicit and implement Medical Director input into identified clinical problems.

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#### AB 749 (Nazarian): Medical Director Certification

- HSC 1261.4.
- A skilled nursing facility shall not contract with a person as a medical director if the person is not, or will not be within five years, certified by the American Board of Post-Acute and Long-Term Care Medicine as a Certified Medical Director.

## What Is a CMD?

- Credential through the American Board of Post-Acute and Long-Term Care Medicine (ABPLM)
  - Only organization providing such a credential
- Requires 46 hours of education (core curriculum)
  - Can be done online
- Covers 22 critical areas of PALTC practice, administration and leadership
- Requires ongoing education (CMD credits) and must be renewed every 6 years
- Total cost to achieve certification ~\$3500

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#### CMDs In California

- · About 150 current CMDs
- ~1300 Skilled Nursing Facilities
- So only a small fraction of California facilities have certified medical directors
  - Some have medical directors who lack basic knowledge of geriatric medicine principles and the complex regulatory framework of SNFs
  - Some have medical directors who serve only to drive admissions to the facility
- The problems that arise from poorly qualified, disengaged medical directors have been highlighted during the pandemic
