

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

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AMDA 2022 House of Delegates Summary

- A22: advocate for a nationwide and streamlined approach to both a consistent nomenclature of and for clarity and uniformity in the menu of care and services provided by Assisted Living Communities. PASSED
- B22: medical direction for Assisted Living Communities. FAILED
- C22: preventing unnecessary hospitalization/skilled cert. REF TO BOD
- D22: (CALTCM-sponsored) Transparency in SNF Ownership. PASSED
- E22: (CALTCM-sponsored) Consensus Leadership. REFERRED TO
- F22: Promoting and Implementing the Principles of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in all Care Settings of PALTC. PASSED

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AMDA 2022 House of Delegates Summary


- G22 (Late): designate all Post-Acute and Long-Term Care communities, irrespective of their geographic location, as Health professional Shortage Areas and/or Medically Underserved Areas to facilitate recruitment and retention of health professionals using the usual and customary support made available for such designations. BOD VOTED TO SUPPORT AND TAKE TO AMA HOD
- H22 (Late): Undocumented non-citizens, pathway to immigration for those who show their commitment to their intended homeland by working as Certified Nursing Assistants and/or Nurses in Post-Acute and Long-Term Care settings for a minimum of five years.
 BOD VOTED TO SUPPORT AND TAKE TO AMA HOD
- I22 (Late): SED by AD: Referred back to Board

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
