

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






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SNF Lessons Learned

- Verbal consent
- Vaccine Confidence amongst staff
- Rigidity of "clinics"
- How to vaccinate new residents, staff
- · How will vaccinations impact visitation and testing rules





Pharmacy Partnership Problem Areas

- Little/no Industry expertise
 Didn't know LTC/ALF terminology, variety, governance
 Didn't understand how often residents would miss vaccination clinics
- Consent

 - Corporate-focused legal protections, not facility-, resident- or staff-centered
 Forms with challenging print size, PHI, language,

literacy • Communication With facilities: unclear, inconsistent, not timely

Lots of time wasted by all parties because of facility anxiety in communication vacuum
 Leadership v. field staff, different regions: different


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Pharmacy Partnership Problem Areas • Data Redundancies Some sites appear many times on lists · No single source • CDC →state →DPH = game of telephone \rightarrow errors Inadequate Only tracking how #vaccinated/#in facility Critical data not being collected Reasons for hesitancy/refusal 0101 00 10000 Side effects in residents Follow-up Nothing official, team dependent





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COVID Vaccines in Assisted Living

- Communication is key (phone, email, etc)
- Consents and insurance Do you have current Medicare numbers?
- $\bullet \, Scheduling Be \, flexible$
- Previously COVID positive <u>CAN</u> be vaccinated
- TB tests should wait 4 weeks after vaccination
- What if I miss my second dose?



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
