
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
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
Bamlanivimab Allocations in California


- Week 1: 4040 vials allocated to California
- Weekly allocations expected
- 1 vial = 1 dose = 1 treatment course
- Delivery for week 1 to acute care hospitals
- Allocation based on 7-day hospitalizations of COVID-confirmed patients by county


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
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












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
